### Safer online behaviour

81% of teachers have noticed safer online behaviours from young people as a result of the programme

75% of teachers said the ethos of the school has improved to promote kindness and respect both online and offline

38% of teachers said Digital Leaders have improved in behaviour

30% of teachers said there has been a reduction in the number of online safeguarding incidents

100% of Digital Leaders said the training made them more knowledgeable about online safety

93% of Digital Leaders said the training made them feel more confident about educating pupils in their school

84% of Digital Leaders feel they can make a difference in their school

83% of teachers said Digital Leaders are more confident

79% of teachers said Digital Leaders have improved wellbeing
