Your Digital Leaders will soon be taking a lead in running activities to impact your educational setting! However, to successfully run the programme, there are a few requirements to follow, so that your team will get the best experience as Childnet Digital Leaders.

Staff time commitment

Your school should allocate a member of staff to oversee the programme and meet regularly with the students. We recommend that the Digital Leaders spend around an hour a week on their activities to help them maximise the potential impact of the programme. They could meet up at lunch, after school or in form time. Digital Leaders should be able to complete their training on the online platform within 2-3 months and then they have the rest of the year to continue to work together to deliver impactful activities in your school community.

We'll stay in touch throughout the year to make sure that you are supported and happy with how things are progressing, as well as updated with Digital Leader achievements and opportunities.

Technical requirements

The training platform is accessible on desktops, laptops and tablets. The Digital Leaders will each require access to individual devices when they meet. Secondary pupils can access the training platform independently but primary pupils need to log in via their teacher's account so can only do so with a teacher present. To ensure that everything runs smoothly we have a few requirements that we recommend sharing with your IT support:

- JavaScript must be enabled on all devices
- The URL for the online platform may need to be whitelisted so that Digital Leaders have no trouble accessing the training
- Our email address, leaders@childnet.com, may also need to be whitelisted across your network
